

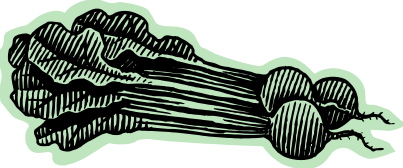

When you join the Greenbank Farm CSA program as a member, you'll receive 20 weeks of freshly harvested organic vegetables bursting with flavor and nutrition! Grown by the staff and students of the Greenbank Farm Training Center, your membership helps support our nonprofit educational center while providing you with top quality vegetables at an affordable price.

Our share is sized for couples or small families who cook with vegetables often. We focus on providing a steady and abundant supply of the staple vegetables like lettuce, carrots, onions, and tomatoes while offering a rotating sampling of specialty crops such as arugula, fennel, parsnips and bok-choi. The vegetables offered in this year's share include lettuce, green beans, broccoli, tomatoes, garlic, carrots, chard, onions, leeks, cucumbers, summer and winter squash, fennel, kale, bok-choi, beets, arugula, oriental greens, parsnips, peas, cauliflower, potatoes, rutabagas, spinach, brussel sprouts, cabbage, turnips, basil, cilantro, parsley, radishes, and more!



We strive to offer good value with our produce share and our price of \$450 is 20% below its retail value. A payment plan option is available. Several pick-up sites (exact locations to be announced soon) will serve members from Oak Harbor through South Whidbey.
